

## Summary World Championships

### **Accommodation**

The official hotel is the 4 stars hotel Axxon in Brandenburg-an-der-Havel. It is 5,9 km away from the competition course (9 min. by car).

### **Transport**

The airport Berlin Tegel is 82 km away from the competition course (1 h by car).

The airport Berlin Schoenefeld is 90 km away from the competition course (1 h by car).

The central station of Berlin is 88 km away from the competition course (1 h by car).

### **Opening and Closing Ceremony**

The opening ceremony will take place on the 7th of August 2010 at the competition site, with guests of honor and a super firework show with a modern pyrotechnic display.

The Closing Ceremony will take place in the Stahlpalast, the event hall of Hotel Axxon, on the 15th of August 2010.

### **Schedule**

The elimination rounds of the competition will start on Saturday, 07.08.2010 and will continue until Friday, 13.08.2010. The finals will be held on Saturday, 14.08.2010 and Sunday, 15.08.2010.

The competition can take place up to 22:00 pm each evening with floodlights, whereby viewers from Brandenburg have the chance to watch during the week. There will also be live music for entertainment in the evenings.

## **Competition Course**

The Competition Course in Brandenburg-an-der-Havel is newly restored and expanded, modern and ideal for any kind of water sport. The continuous modernization of the competition course began in the middle of the 90s. It has a capacity of approximately 5000 seats. The city Brandenburg-an-der-Havel and the federal state of Brandenburg have invested a lot of money into the expansion of the buildings, the improvement of its infrastructure and the installation of modern, competition technology.

The competition course on the "Beetzsee" (a lake) in Brandenburg was already the venue of several national and international competitions for different kinds of water sports. It was the venue for the European Championships for Rowing in 1972, the Junior Rowing World Championships in 1985 and in 2005, the Canoe Marathon at the German National Championships in 2005, the Under 23 World Rowing Championships in 2008, and in 2010 the site of the Barefoot World Championships.

The competition course is 2000 meters long and there will be events between 0 and 1000 meters, and between 1000 and 2000 meters. The two courses will be clearly marked and separated by buoys.

The jump event and the finals will be carried out on the course in front of the tribune.

## **Training**

Training can be booked from the 1st of August to the 7th of August 2010 on 2 to 3 different sites for ca. 12 hours per day. The skiers can train with the official boats of the World Championships.

Course 1: Competition Course 0-1000 m

Course 2: Competition Course 1000-2000 m

Course 3: Havel (River) approx. 10 km from the site

Costs for training: 125 €/hour for the first 5 hours, from the sixth hour on 100 €/hour (including petrol)
